2. Venue	Manutsangkhomwattana Meeting Hall, Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences (Building 25), Buriram Rajabhat University, Buriram, Thailand

4. Theme	Social Media	
5. Student Eligibility	Undergraduate students holding the nationalities of 10 ASEAN countries (Thailand, Brunei, Cambodia, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, Philippines, Singapore, and Vietnam) + 6 (China, Japan, Korea, India, Australia, and New Zealand) are eligible to participate in the “BRU English Speech Competition”. (All competitors must bring a duplicate student ID card with them)	
6. Guidelines for Competition	<p>6.1 Three maximum individuals from each institution are accepted for this competition.</p> <p>6.2 Dress Code: All competitors are expected to wear their formal student uniforms during the competition.</p> <p>6.3 They must submit three copies of a prepared speech script on the competition day.</p> <p>6.4 They are not allowed to look at their prepared speech script and to use all facilities while delivering a speech.</p>	
7. Criteria for Competition	<p>This competition is divided into two rounds as follows:</p> <p>7.1 <u>The elimination round</u> (prepared speech):</p> <p>1) The competitors in this round will be given the entry number by drawing lots on February 14, 2023.</p> <p>2) Five-eight minutes will be allocated for each competitor to deliver a speech on the given topic: “The role of social media in modern society”</p> <p>3) The five competitors getting the highest scores (or who have the highest equal scores) are qualified to enter the final round.</p> <p>7.2 <u>The final round</u> (impromptu speech):</p> <p>1) The competitors in this round will draw lots to get the sequent number and the impromptu speech topic will be also drawn.</p> <p>2) Three-five minutes will be allocated for delivering a speech.</p>

	2. Content: Relatedness to the Theme, Language Usage, Comprehensibility, Sequence, Conclusion	40
	3. Voice Usage: Pronunciation, Accent, Cluster, Final Sound	25
	4. Appearance: Body Language, Eye Contact, Personality	15
	5. Time Management: Appropriateness	5
